PURPOSE: The Scholarship Committee of FUSTA was formed for the purpose of awarding an academic scholarship to a highland dancer who has devoted years of their lives in the pursuit of Highland Dancing.

The FUSTA Scholarship will provide financial assistance to a United States dancer who has met the eligibility requirements. This dancer must demonstrate a high level of participation and interest in the art of Highland Dancing.

ELIGIBILITY: This scholarship will be open to current-year registered dancers who are in college or graduate school. Applicants must be US residents who are either members of FUSTA themselves or their teachers are members in good standing.

FINANCIAL: The scholarship will be \$1000. Funds will be paid directly to the recipient for the purpose of further education.

CRITERIA for applicants: Applicants must complete and submit an application form to the Scholarship Committee by April 30 of the current year. Information that must accompany the application:

1. Three letters of recommendation
 - one from the dance teacher
 - one from a schoolteacher
 - one personal reference letter (not from a member of the immediate family)
 2. College transcripts
 3. Information regarding extra curricular activities
 4. Written paper (maximum 500 words)
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Deadline: Completed application materials must be postmarked not later than April 30th of the current year for the Fall semester. Applicants will be notified by June 15th.
