



FUSTA Hall Of Fame

Purpose:

To honor past or present members of FUSTA who have furthered Highland Dancing in the United States. The honorees will be inducted into the Hall of Fame each year at the USIR.

Criteria:

1. The nominee is a current member or past member (if no longer living) of FUSTA.
2. The nominee is a member who has provided ten or more years of service to FUSTA.
3. The nominee has impacted the lives of others in the area of Highland Dance.
4. The nominee has encouraged others to continue their education in the area of Highland Dance.

Nomination Procedure:

1. Either an individual or a region may nominate a candidate.
2. A separate nomination form (available on the FUSTA web site) should be submitted for each nominee.

3. Any individuals nominating a candidate must be current FUSTA members.
4. The Hall of Fame committee will review the nominations and choose the persons to be inducted for the current year.
5. No more than two people will be inducted in any given year with the exception of the first year.
6. If no nominee has been put forth in a given year, the Hall of Fame committee may nominate a candidate.
