

FUSTA SCHOLARSHIP HARRY FARRAR IV MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE: The Scholarship Committee of FUSTA was formed for the purpose of awarding an academic scholarship to a highland dancer who has devoted years of their lives in the pursuit of Highland Dancing.

The FUSTA Scholarship will provide financial assistance to a United States dancer who has met the eligibility requirements. This dancer must demonstrate a high level of participation and interest in the art of Highland Dancing.

ELIGIBILTY: This scholarship will be open to current year registered dancers who are either high school seniors or high school graduates preparing to enroll in their first year beyond high school. Applicants must be US residents who are either members of FUSTA themselves or their teachers are members in good standing.

FINANCIAL: The scholarship will be \$1000. Funds will be paid directly to the recipient for the purpose of further education.

CRITERIA for applicants: Applicants must complete and submit an application form to the Scholarship Committee by April 30 of the current year. Information that must accompany the application:

- 1. Three letters of recommendation
 - one from the dance teacher
 - one from a schoolteacher
 - one personal reference letter (not from a member of the immediate family)
- 2. Copies of the high school transcripts
- 3. Information regarding extra curricular activities
- 4. Written paper Choice of 3 topics for an essay (maximum 500 words)

- 2. If you were President of FUSTA where would your leadership take the organization?
- 3. What avenues have been opened to you as a result of your Highland Dancing?

As part of your application process, you must submit college transcripts and three recommendation letters; one from a dance teacher, one from a school teacher, and one personal reference letter not from an immediate family member.

Completed application materials must be postmarked no later than April 30. Recipients will be notified by June 15.
